In An Amount Not To Exceed \$49,971.00; Authorizing The City Manager To Enter Into Agreements In Connection Therewith, Appropriating And Expending Funds; And Providing For An Effective Date BACKGROUND & JUSTIFICATION: The City has certain areas that are low lying and are often inundated by certain rainfall events in combination with high and king tides. The situation restricts the flow of stormwater through some of our wells due to the lack of head pressure to push the water down the wells. To remedy this situation, stormwater is required to be pumped into the well providing for a positive discharge down the well. We currently utilize a 4" pump with limited capacity. The 6-inch trailer mounted pump would provide close to five times the capacity, allowing the low lying roads to be fully operation in significantly less time, thus minimizing the impact to our residents. The pump will also serve as an emergency back-up to the new pump station proposed in the Sombrero area, the existing station at 39th Street, and any future Stormwater Pump station installed. The Pump cost, utilizing the Florida Sheriff's Association contract, is \$49,971.00, inclusive of all charges and required options. CONSISTENCY CHECKLIST: Yes No 1. Comprehensive Plan 2. WHEREAS, the Purchasing Policies and Procedures allow the City Council to enter into contracts for materials, supplies, equipment, public improvements or services without competitive bidding by utilizing existing contract terms and prices entered into by other local, state or federal governmental authorities that followed a competitive bidding procedure leading to the award of the contract in question; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to take advantage of the Florida Sheriffs' Association Contract FSA23-EQU21.0 from Thompson Pump & Manufacturing Company, Inc. for a six-inch trailer mounted pump In An Amount Not To Exceed \$49,971.00

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, THAT:
