**CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA
RESOLUTION 2024-91**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, ADOPTING THE FINAL MILLAGE RATE AND LEVY OF AD VALOREM TAXES FOR THE CITY OF MARATHON OF MONROE COUNTY, FLORIDA FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2024-2025; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on September 17, 2024, the City Council held a public hearing to consider any adjustment of its proposed millage rate, to adopt a tentative millage rate, and to adopt a tentative operating budget for Fiscal Year 2024-2025 (the “FY 2024-2025”), in accordance with Section 200.065(2)(c), *Florida Statutes* and

WHEREAS, on September 24, 2024, the City Council held a public hearing to consider any adjustment of its tentative millage rate, to adopt a final millage rate and to adopt a final operating budget for FY 2024-2025, in accordance with Section 200.065(2)(d), *Florida Statutes*.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. The FY 2024-2025 final millage rate for the City of Marathon is 2.2235 mills, which is \$2.2235 for each thousand dollars of taxable assessed property value; and the final millage rate is equal the rolled-back rate of 2.2235 mills.

Section 3. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon its adoption.
