A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO SUPPLY THE MARATHON VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT WITH THE MATCH FOR THE FIRE SAFETY TRAILER IN THE AMOUNT OF \$5,000.00 OF THE FEMA GRANT AWARDED TO THE CITY; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AND CITY ATTORNEY TO FINALIZE THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ANY DOCUMENTATION NECESSARY TO FACILITATE SAID REQUEST; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE ANY DOCUMENTATION NECESSARY FOR SAID REQUEST; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Marathon ("City") desires to supply the Marathon Volunteer Fire Department with the match for the Fire Safety Trailer in the amount of \$5,000.00 of the FEMA Grant awarded to the City.




Section 3. **Effective Date.** This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption


