A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, EXEMPTING THE CHURCH LOCATED ON LOT 2, BLOCK G, HAWAIIAN VILLAGE SUBDIVISION FROM THE COMMERCIAL DEVELOPMENT MORATORIUM AS REQUIRED BY POLICY 101.3.4 OF THE CITY OF MARATHON INTERIM COMPREHENSIVE PLAN

WHEREAS, the churches provide a valuable service to the residents of the City of Marathon and the Florida Keys; and

WHEREAS, the Martin Luther Chapel located at 325 122nd Street Gulf, Lot 2, Block G, Hawaiian Village Subdivision wishes to apply for a development/building permit; and

WHEREAS, Section 101.3.4 of the City of Marathon Interim Comprehensive Plan provides for the development activity by federally tax-exempt non-profit social service agencies; and

WHEREAS, the development activity will not adversely impact the hurricane evacuation objects of the Interim Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, the new development will be constructed to withstand category 5 hurricane storm conditions; and

WHEREAS, the Martin Luther Chapel located at 325 122nd Street Gulf, Lot 2, Block G, Hawaiian Village Subdivision will provide a restrictive covenant providing that the property will not be used as a for-profit commercial development.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. Council exempts the Martin Luther Chapel located at 325 122nd Street Gulf, Lot 2, Block G, Hawaiian Village Subdivision from the commercial moratorium as required by Policy 101.3.4 of the City of Marathon Interim Comprehensive Plan.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
