**CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA
RESOLUTION 2003-089**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, REQUESTING THE STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AFFAIRS AND DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH WORK WITH THE CITY OF MARATHON FOR THE EARLY RELEASE OF 150 NUTRIENT CREDITS FROM THE LITTLE VENICE WASTEWATER PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City of Marathon has received a total of 142 affordable Rate of Growth Ordinance (ROGO) allocations from Monroe County; and

WHEREAS, the City of Marathon currently has nutrient credits to match 67 of the affordable ROGO allocations received from the County; and

WHEREAS, the City of Marathon has 23 nutrient credits to match 23 ROGO allocations for Year 12; and

WHEREAS, the City of Marathon has requested 50 additional market rate ROGO allocations from Monroe County; and

WHEREAS, the Little Venice wastewater project will become operational by November 2003.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. The City Council directs City Staff to work with the State of Florida Department of Health and the Department of Community Affairs to release 150 nutrient credits from the Little Venice wastewater project to become available immediately.


Section 2. The City Council respectfully requests that the Department of Health release 150 nutrient credits for use within the corporate boundaries of the City of Marathon effective immediately through a Memorandum of Understanding.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
