**RESOLUTION 2003-098**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, DETERMINING THE PROPOSED MILLAGE RATE AND THE CURRENT YEAR ROLLED-BACK MILLAGE RATE**

**WHEREAS**, on June 30, 2003, Ervin A. Higgs, Property Appraiser of Monroe County, Florida (the "Property Appraiser") served upon the City of Marathon (the "City") a Certification of Taxable Value (the "Certification") certifying to the City its 2003 taxable value; and

**WHEREAS**, the provisions of Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, require that the City, within thirty-five (35) days of service of the Certification, furnish to the Property Appraiser the proposed millage rate, the current year rolled-back rate and the date, time and place at which public hearings will be held to consider the proposed millage rate and the tentative budget.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:**

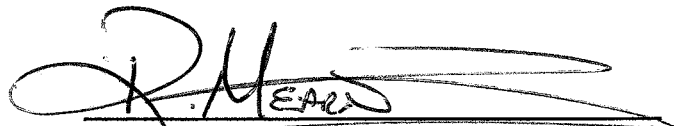
**Section 1.** The proposed millage rate for the City of Marathon for Fiscal Year 2003-04 is declared to be 2.9645, which is \$2.9645 per each \$1,000.00 of assessed taxable value of property within the City of Marathon.

**Section 2.** The current year rolled-back millage rate as computed pursuant to Section 200.065, Florida Statutes is 2.4931, which is \$2.4931 per \$1,000.00 of assessed taxable value of property within the City of Marathon.

**Section 3.** This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.

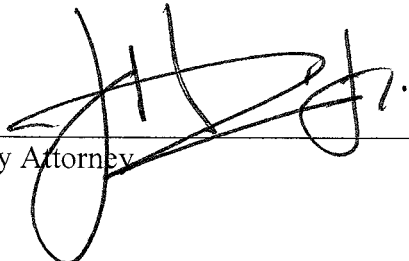
