RESOLUTION 2003-131**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
MARATHON, FLORIDA, APPOINTING A PLANNING COMMISSON**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 9(6)(A) of the City of Marathon City Charter (the “Charter”), the Monroe County Land Development Regulations (the “LDRs”) in effect upon the date of the City’s incorporation are the City’s LDRs until such time as they are amended or replaced; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 9(6)(B) of the Charter, the City Council serves as the Planning Commission until such time as the City Council delegates all or a portion of the powers and duties of the Planning Commission to another entity; and

WHEREAS, Section 9.5-22 of the LDRs provides for the appointment, removal, terms, and vacancies of the Planning Commission.

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to establish a separate Planning Commission with members appointed by the City Council; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, THAT:**

Section 1. In accordance with Section 9.5-22(d) of the LDRS the Planning Commission shall be comprised of five (5) appointed members with terms indicted as listed below.


<u>Mike Cinque</u>	3 years
<u>Morgan Hill</u>	3 years
<u>Tracy Holder</u>	3 years
<u>Brian Schmitt</u>	2 years
<u>Bill Smith</u>	2 years

Section 2. The powers and duties of the Planning Commission shall be consistent with the applicable provisions of Section 9.5-22 of the LDRS.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon approval of Ordinance 2003-20 by the State Department of Community Affairs in accordance with State law.




