**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
MARATHON, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF MARINE  
PILINGS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$28,500 FROM MARATHON  
SEAWALLS AND DOCKS FOR INSTALLATION AT THE CITY MARINA**

**WHEREAS**, a special piling is required for the construction of floating docks at the City Marina; and

**WHEREAS**, the pilings are comprised of spun carbon fiber in concrete, are manufactured overseas, only one company markets and sells the pilings in the United States, and requires prepayment and a minimum lot order for shipping; and

**WHEREAS**, Marathon Seawall and Docks, Inc. is willing to place the order for the pilings, as a contractor is needed to order, receive, and offload the pilings at a quoted price of \$28,500; and

**WHEREAS**, this purchase will exceed the \$10,000 purchasing policy limit, however, it is a sole source item purchase, and as such, exempt from the City's adopted purchasing policies and procedures.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, THAT:**

**Section 1.** The City Council authorizes the purchase of marine pilings in the amount of \$28,500 from Marathon Seawall and Docks, Inc., a sole source provider. This is a budgeted item in the Capital Infrastructure fund.

**Section 2.** This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.


