WHEREAS, the City of Marathon, Florida (the "City") owns and maintains a 1950 La France Fire Engine (the "Fire Engine"); and

WHEREAS, Marathon Volunteer Fire and Rescue, Inc., ("VFR") has historically collected funds for the restoration of the Fire Engine and desires a right of first refusal should the City ever decide to sell or dispose of the Fire Engine; and

WHEREAS, the City has agreed to grant VFR a right of first refusal on the Fire Engine.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, THAT:


Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.




