**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
MARATHON, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING THE FLORIDA KEYS  
INITIATIVE**

**WHEREAS**, the Florida Keys Initiative (“FKI”), made up of several entities including the City of Marathon (the “City”), was formed to request grants and appropriations to fund small, environmentally related projects in the Florida Keys; and

**WHEREAS**, the FKI has compiled a list of projects to be funded by any grant money received; and

**WHEREAS**, one of the listed projects is the restoration of Coco Plum Beach, which is located within the City.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, THAT:**


**Section 1.** The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.

**Section 2.** The City of Marathon supports the request for funds to fund small, environmentally related projects by the Florida Keys Initiative, of which the City is a part. 
