**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
MARATHON, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE CITY'S FISCAL YEAR 2004-
2005 BUDGET**

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted a budget for fiscal year 2004-2005 via Resolution No. 2004-104; and

WHEREAS in accordance with Florida Statutes, it is necessary for the City Council to adjust the budget to move Culture/Recreation Impact Fees in the amount of \$19,926.25 into Capital Infrastructure and to move Public Safety Impact Fees in the amount of \$6300 into Capital Infrastructure.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, THAT:


Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.

Section 2. The City Council hereby approves the transfer of Culture/Recreation Impact Fees in the amount of \$19,926.25 into Capital Infrastructure Fund and the transfer of Public Safety Impact Fees in the amount of \$6300 into Capital Infrastructure Fund.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.




