A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF MARATHON AND MONROE COUNTY, TO PROVIDE BEACH SAND, REPAIRS AND BEACH MAINTENANCE; EXTENDING THE AGREEMENT FOR AN ADDITIONAL FIVE (5) YEAR PERIOD

WHEREAS, On June 1, 2001, the City of Marathon, Florida (the "City") entered into an agreement with the Tourist Development Council of Monroe County (the "County") for reimbursement of certain beach maintenance expenses at Sombrero Beach (the "Agreement"); and

**WHEREAS**, On November 21, 2001, the first amendment to the Agreement was approved adding Coco Plum Beach to the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement is expiring and has a provision for one (1) five (5) year extension; and

**WHEREAS**, the City and the County wish to extend the Agreement for an additional five (5) years.

# NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, THAT:

- **Section 1**. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.
- **Section 2.** The Second Amendment to the Agreement between the City of Marathon and the Tourist Development Council of Monroe County to provide beach sand, repairs and beach maintenance; extending the agreement for an additional five (5) year period a copy of which is attached as Exhibit "A" together with such non-material changes as may be acceptable to the City Manager and approved as to form and legality by the City Attorney, is approved.
  - **Section 3**. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

# **AMENDMENT TO INTER-LOCAL AGREEMENT**

On June 1, 2001, the City entered into an agreement with Tourist Development Council (TDC) of Monroe County for reimbursement of certain expenses relating to beach maintenance for Sombrero Beach. On November 21, 2001, amendment # 1 was approved adding Coco Plum Beach to the agreement. The original agreement is now expiring with a provision for one (1) five (5) year extension. The contract period with amendment # 2 will now expire on September 30, 2010. The current reimbursable amount is \$115,887.
