**RESOLUTION 2005-129**

**A RESOLUTION OF CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, ADOPTING  
THE TENTATIVE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2005-2006**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 200.065, *Florida Statutes* the City of Marathon, Florida (the "City") has established a proposed millage rate; and


**WHEREAS**, on September 6, 2005, the City Council held a public hearing to consider any adjustment of its proposed millage rate, to consider its tentative operating budget for Fiscal Year 2005-2006 (the "FY 2005-2006"), and adopt a tentative millage rate in accordance with Section 200.065(2)(c), *Florida Statutes*; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has set forth the appropriations and revenue estimate for the tentative operating budget for FY 2005-2006 in the amount of \$33,094,252.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1.** The FY 2005-2006 tentative operating budget is adopted.
- Section 2.** This resolution shall be effective immediately upon its adoption.




