A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, ELECTING TO USE THE UNIFORM METHOD OF COLLECTING NON-AD VALOREM SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS FOR WASTEWATER LEVIED WITHIN THE INCORPORATED AREA OF THE CITY; STATING A NEED FOR SUCH LEVY

WHEREAS, The City of Marathon (the "City") is contemplating the imposition of special assessments for the provision of wastewater treatment services and facilities; and

WHEREAS, the City intends to use the uniform method for collecting non-ad valorem special assessments for the cost of providing wastewater treatment services and facilities to property within the incorporated area of the City as authorized by Section 197.3632, Florida Statutes, as amended, because this method will allow such special assessments to be collected annually commencing in November 2006, in the same manner as provided for ad valorem taxes; and

WHEREAS, the City held a duly advertised public hearing prior to the adoption of this Resolution, proof of publication of such hearing being attached hereto as Exhibit"A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1**. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.
- Section 2. Commencing with the Fiscal Year beginning on October 1, 2006, and with the tax statement mailed for such Fiscal Year, the City intends to use the uniform method of collecting non-ad valorem assessments authorized in Section 197.3632, Florida Statutes, as amended, for collecting non-ad valorem assessments for the cost of providing wastewater treatment services and facilities. Such non-ad valorem assessments shall be levied within the incorporated area of the City. A legal description of such area subject to the assessment is attached hereto as Exhibit B and incorporated by reference.
- **Section 3**. The City hereby determines that the levy of the assessments it needed to fund the cost of wastewater treatment services and facilities within the incorporated area of the City.
- **Section 4.** Upon adoption, the City Clerk is hereby directed to send of copy of this Resolution by United States mail to the Florida Department of Revenue, the Monroe County Tax Collector, and the Monroe County Property Appraiser by March 1, 2006.

Section 5. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.





The Marathon City Council will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, December 13, 2005 at 6:30 p.m., at the Marathon Government Center, 2798 Overseas Highway.

The purpose of the public hearing is to consider and establish a Waste Water Utility. The Waste Water Utility collects funds to construct and maintain wastewater systems throughout the City. These funds will be collected as a non-ad valorem assessment on the property tax bill. Failure to pay the assessment will cause a tax certificate to be issued against the property, which may result in loss of title.

All property owners in the City of Marathon have a right to appear at this Public Hearing and to file written objections with the City of Marathon within 20 days of the date of this notice.
