RESOLUTION 2006-001**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE REQUEST BY THE CITY OF MARATHON FOR A ONE YEAR EXTENSION TO A MAJOR CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT ISSUED JULY 26, 2005, PURSUANT TO SECTION 9.5-69 OF THE CITY OF MARATHON CODE, AT PROPERTY LOCATED AT 8900 OVERSEAS HIGHWAY AND LEGALLY DESCRIBED AS PART OF GOVERNMENT LOTS 1, 3, AND 4, SECTION 1, TOWNSHIP 66 SOUTH, RANGE 32 EAST, KEY VACCAS, MONROE COUNTY, FLORIDA, HAVING REAL ESTATE NUMBER 00101160-000000

WHEREAS, on July 26, 2005, the City of Marathon City Council approved Resolution 2005-100, which granted major conditional use approval to the City of Marathon (the "Applicant") for the redevelopment of a fire station facility pursuant to Sections 9.5-69 of the City Code (the "Code"); and

WHEREAS, the Applicant has requested an extension to the major conditional use permit pursuant to Section 9.5-72; and

WHEREAS, on November 21, 2005, the City of Marathon Planning Commission and on December 13, 2005, the City of Marathon City Council, conducted properly advertised public hearings regarding the request submitted by the Applicant, for an extension to a major conditional use permit.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, THAT:


Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.


