RESOLUTION 2006-006**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, APPROVING A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY (FEMA) AUTHORIZING THE USE OF CITY OWNED PROPERTY FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING LOCATIONS FOR THE PLACEMENT OF TEMPORARY EMERGENCY HOUSING WITHIN THE CITY'S JURISDICTIONAL LIMITS

WHEREAS, the City of Marathon has suffered significant property damage, particularly due to the storm surge from Hurricane Wilma, which has resulted in a demand for temporary emergency housing; and

WHEREAS, the continued need for emergency temporary housing during disaster recovery from the effects of Hurricane Wilma requires the City Council to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding (the "MOU") with FEMA authorizing the temporary placement of recreational vehicles on property owned by the City.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. The MOU between the City and FEMA in the form attached as Exhibit "A," together with such non-substantial changes as may be acceptable to the City Manager and approved as to form and legality by the City Attorney, is approved. The City Manager is authorized to sign the agreement on behalf of the City.

Section 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.




