A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO CREATE A PUBLIC WORKS MANAGER POSITION AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$37,125.00

WHEREAS, The City of Marathon is developing a Stormwater and Wastewater Utility requiring additional manpower; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager desires to provide an appropriate level of oversight for these important public works projects by establishing the position of Public Works Manager.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, THAT:


Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct, and incorporate herein by this reference.
