**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
MARATHON, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER  
TO CREATE A FULL TIME HUMAN RESOURCES DIRECTOR  
POSITION AND APPROPRIATE FUNDS IN AN AMOUNT NOT  
TO EXCEED \$24,000 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2005-2006**

**WHEREAS**, In Fiscal Year 2004-05, the City of Marathon, Florida (the "City") requested a study be performed by LaRue Planning & Management Services, Inc. to evaluate the operational efficiency and effectiveness of various departments within the City; and

**WHEREAS**, one of the highest priority recommendations made by LaRue in the study included the establishment of a full time Human Resources Department with a full time Human Resources Director; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Manager wishes to create a full time Human Resources Director Position to allow full attention to be placed on the hiring process, overall recruitment, personnel issues, and the handling of employee insurance.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, THAT:**


**Section 1.** The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein.

**Section 2.** The City Council authorizes the City Manager to create a full time Human Resources Director position and appropriates funds in an amount not to exceed \$24,000.

**Section 3.** This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.


