RESOLUTION 2006-144

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, ADOPTING THE FINAL LEVY OF AD VALOREM TAXES FOR THE CITY OF MARATHON OF MONROE COUNTY, FLORIDA FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2006-2007

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 200.065, *Florida Statutes* the City of Marathon, Florida (the "City") has established a proposed millage rate; and

WHEREAS, the gross taxable value for operating purposes not exempt from taxation within Monroe County has been certified by the County Property Appraiser to the City as \$2,834,425,626; and

WHEREAS, on September 5, 2006, the City Council held a public hearing to consider any adjustment of its proposed millage rate, to adopt a tentative millage rate, and to adopt a tentative operating budget for Fiscal Year 2006-2007 (the "FY 2006-2007"), in accordance with Section 200.065(2)(c), Florida Statutes and

WHEREAS, on September 12, 2006, the City Council held a public hearing to consider any adjustment of its tentative millage rate, to adopt a final millage rate and to adopt a final operating budget for FY 2006-2007, in accordance with Section 200.065(2)(d), Florida Statutes.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The FY 2006-2007 final operating millage rate for the City is 1.7896 mills, which is greater than the rolled-back rate of 1.6315 mills by 9.69%.

Section 2. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon its adoption.
