WHEREAS, the City Council at its March 28, 2006 meeting voted unanimously, by motion to award three affordable allocations to Harris Johnson Insurance Corporation for the construction of three affordable single family dwelling unit at Johnson Insurance Agency located at 13361 Overseas Highway.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1**. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.
- **Section 2**. The City Council hereby awards three affordable ROGO allocations to Harris Johnson Insurance Corporation for the construction of three affordable single family dwelling unit at Johnson Insurance Agency located at 13361 Overseas Highway.
- **Section 3**. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
