**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
MARATHON, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING THE FLORIDA KEYS
INITIATIVE**

WHEREAS, the Florida Keys Initiative (“FKI”), made up of several entities including the City of Marathon (the “City”), was formed to request grants and appropriations to fund small, environmentally related projects in the Florida Keys; and

WHEREAS, the FKI has compiled a list of projects to be funded by any grant money received; and

WHEREAS, two of the listed projects are the stormwater funding for Little Venice Phase I and a study to restore tidal flow to the Coco Plum Beach salt ponds, which are both located within the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, THAT:


Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.

Section 2. The City of Marathon supports the request for funds to fund small, environmentally related projects by the Florida Keys Initiative, of which the City is a part. If the FKI is successful in obtaining grant funding, the City desires that, if funds are available, they be used for Little Venice Phase I stormwater improvements and the restoration of Coco Plum Beach salt ponds.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.




