A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, DETERMINING TWO VEHICLES AS SHOWN ON EXHIBIT "A" TO BE SURPLUS; DIRECTING THAT THE SURPLUS VEHICLES BE SOLD THROUGH A PUBLIC BID PROCESS; PLACING ALL PROCEEDS INTO THE APPROPRIATE FUND FROM WHICH THE ASSETS WERE ORIGINALLY PURCHASED; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, the vehicles described on Exhibit A attached hereto have exceeded their useful life as City vehicles and have been replaced by additional vehicles to the City's fleet; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Manager is recommending that the vehicles be deemed surplus items and be sold to the highest bidder through a public bid process and that the City reserve the right to not accept bids; and

WHEREAS, the proceeds of the bid will be used to offset the costs of the recently purchased vehicles.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, THAT:

- **Section 1**. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.
- **Section 2**. Council hereby authorizes the two surplus vehicles described on Exhibit A hereto to be sold through a public bid process and reserves the right to not accept unacceptable bids based on price.
  - Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
