**CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA
RESOLUTION 2007-152**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO CONDUCT A COST ANALYSIS AND FEASIBILITY STUDY OF EXPANDING THE CITY MARINA BY ADDING MORE SLIPS AND POSSIBLY INCLUDING RETAIL ACTIVITIES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Marathon (the “City”) is very dependent on marine-related activities for the creation of jobs and revenue; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City Council to promote activities and investments that will revitalize and expand the economy of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council recognizes that the City Marina is a valuable public resource that also plays an important economic role in the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council believes that it is worth exploring all opportunities to upgrade the City Marina and make it an even more valuable public resource.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.

Section 2. The City Council hereby directs the City Manager to conduct a cost analysis and feasibility study of expanding the City Marina by adding more slips and possibly including retail and commercial activities. The City Manager is directed to report to the City Council within one hundred twenty (120) days with the results of the study.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.


