A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, DIRECTING CITY STAFF TO CONDUCT A COST ANALYSIS AND FEASIBILITY STUDY OF HAVING CITY EMPLOYEES PERFORM THE BOOK KEEPING FUNCTIONS FOR THE CITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Marathon (the "City") currently out sources its finance department function to the firm of Bishop, Rosasco and Associates; and

WHEREAS, Bishop, Rosasco and Associates provide outstanding service to the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has an obligation to identify possible cost savings while still maintaining high service levels; and

**WHEREAS**, the daily bookkeeping functions may represent one portion of the firm's services that could be performed by City employees at significantly reduced cost while still maintaining the other valuable services of the firm.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, THAT:

**Section 1.** The City Council hereby directs the City Manager to conduct a cost analysis and feasibility study of having City employees perform the book keeping functions that are currently being outsourced, and to report to the City Council in one hundred twenty (120) days with the results of such study.

**Section 2.** This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
