**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
MARATHON, FLORIDA, RESCINDING RESOLUTION 2003-132
REGARDING INDIVIDUAL SUBMERGED LAND LEASES; PROVIDING
AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

WHEREAS, there exist submerged lands within the jurisdiction of the City of Marathon (the "City") in Boot Key Harbor known as Parcel 14, in the Sombrero Properties, a sub-division recorded in Plat Book 5, Pages 100-101 of the Public Records of Monroe County, Florida; and

WHEREAS, on October 14, 2003, the City Council adopted Resolution 2003-132 requiring that private individuals residing in or using the waters above these submerged lands enter into Submerged Land Leases with the City; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the efforts by City staff to implement Resolution 2003-132, City staff now recommends that the private individuals be permitted to use the waters above the submerged lands without need of executing any lease.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, THAT:**

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.

Section 2. Resolution 2003-132 is hereby rescinded and shall be of no further force or effect.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
