A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY GRANTS COORDINATOR TO APPLY FOR AND ADMINISTER A FLORIDA BOATING IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM GRANT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF MARATHON.

WHEREAS, the 33rd Street Boat Ramp is in need of repair and renovation; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Fish and Wildlife Commission offers Florida Boating Improvement Program grants to enhance boating access and other boating related activities; and

WHEREAS, a designated program manager must be authorized by the City Council to apply for and administer a Florida Boating Improvement Program grant

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, THAT:


Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.

Section 2. The City Council authorizes the City Grants Coordinator to submit a Florida Boating Improvement Program grant application and administer the grant on behalf of the City of Marathon.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
