**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY LAND STEWARD TO SUBMIT A PROPOSAL FOR AND ADMINISTER A GRANT OF UP TO \$50,000 FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION TO REMOVE INVASIVE EXOTICS FROM CONSERVATION LANDS IN CRAIN'S AND SUNSET BAY SUBDIVISION ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF MARATHON.**

**WHEREAS**, it is the desire of the City Council of the City of Marathon, Florida (the "City") to manage conservation land within the City of Marathon; and

**WHEREAS**, a lease agreement with the State has been signed by the City of Marathon to manage lands in the municipality purchased by the State for the purpose of conservation; and

**WHEREAS**, the Florida Department of Environmental Protection awards money to projects for the removal of invasive exotic vegetation on conservation lands;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, that:**

**Section 1.** The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein

**Section 2.** The City Council authorizes the City Land Steward to submit a proposal to the Florida Department of Environmental Protection for up to \$50,000 for the removal of invasive exotic vegetation within Crain's and Sunset Bay subdivisions on behalf of the City of Marathon.

**Section 3.** This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.




