## CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA RESOLUTION 2007-63

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY LAND STEWARD TO SUMBIT A PROPOSAL FOR AND ADMINSTER A GRANT OF UP TO \$50,000 FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION TO REMOVE INVASIVE EXOTICS FROM CONSERVATION LANDS IN CRAIN'S AND SUNSET BAY SUBDIVISION ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF MARATHON.

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City Council of the City of Marathon, Florida (the "City") to manage conservation land within the City of Marathon; and

WHEREAS, a lease agreement with the State has been signed by the City of Marathon to manage lands in the municipality purchased by the State for the purpose of conservation; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Environmental Protection awards money to projects for the removal of invasive exotic vegetation on conservation lands;

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, that:

- **Section 1**. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein
- **Section 2.** The City Council authorizes the City Land Steward to submit a proposal to the Florida Department of Environmental Protection for up to \$50,000 for the removal of invasive exotic vegetation within Crain's and Sunset Bay subdivisions on behalf of the City of Marathon.
  - **Section 3.** This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
