**CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA
RESOLUTION 2008-121**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING AWARD OF CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT BY THE FLORIDA KEYS AQUEDUCT AUTHORITY (“FKAA”) TO DBF CONSTRUCTION FOR THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF 21 FIRE HYDRANTS IN THE CITY OF MARATHON IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$119,700; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXPEND FUNDS PER THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH FKAA; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Florida Keys Aqueduct Authority (“FKAA”) and the City of Marathon (the “City”) entered into an Interlocal Agreement (the “Agreement”) for installation and maintenance of fire hydrants within the City per Resolution 2007-105 on July 24, 2007; and

WHEREAS, FKAA developed the bid documents for the installation and maintenance of fire hydrants (the “Project”) and advertised the Project in accordance with the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, DBF Construction was the lowest bidder of the seven bids opened on July 17, 2008 and the costs are within FKAA staff estimate of \$126,000; and

WHEREAS, FKAA and City staff recommend award of the Project to DBF Construction;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.


Section 2. The City Council hereby authorizes FKAA to award a contract to DBF Construction for the installation of twenty-one (21) fire hydrants in the City of Marathon, in an amount not to exceed \$119,700.00.

Section 3. The City Manager is authorized to expend funds in an amount not to exceed \$119,700 in accordance with the Agreement on behalf of the City.

Section 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
