A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING INCREASE OF AWARD OF CONTRACT TO AIRVAC INC. FOR PURCHASE OF VACUUM STATION EQUIPMENT FOR SERVICE AREAS 4 WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$5,374.

WHEREAS, on November 27, 2007, City Council awarded by Resolution 2007-175 the direct purchase of the Airvac treatment plant equipment for Service Area 4 in an amount not to exceed \$419,000; and

WHEREAS, Airvac recommends an upgrade to the control system which will allow more efficient operations of the vacuum equipment and reduce the time it takes to recover from a complete loss of vacuum in the system, i.e. post hurricane recovery; and

WHEREAS, the City's engineering firm and staff also recommend this upgrade.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, that:


Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.
