

**CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA
RESOLUTION 2008-26**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, DETERMINING VEHICLE AS SHOWN ON EXHIBIT "A" TO BE SURPLUS; DIRECTING THAT THE SURPLUS VEHICLE BE SOLD THROUGH A PUBLIC BID PROCESS; PLACING ALL PROCEEDS INTO THE APPROPRIATE FUND FROM WHICH THE ASSETS WERE ORIGINALLY PURCHASED; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the vehicles described on Exhibit A attached hereto have exceeded their useful life as City of Marathon Fire Rescue Department vehicles and have been replaced by an additional tanker to the City's fleet; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager is recommending that the vehicles be deemed surplus items and be sold to the highest bidder through a public bid process and that the City reserve the right to not accept bids; and

WHEREAS, the proceeds of the bid will be used to offset the costs of the recently purchased tanker.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, THAT:


Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.


