RESOLUTION 2009-159**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, SIGNING AGREEMENT WITH MUNICIPAL SUPPLY & SIGN CO. FOR NEW FEDERAL HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION (FHWA) SIGN CRITERIA USING 3M® GRANT PROGRAM IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$35,000 AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AND CITY ATTORNEY TO FINALIZE THE TERMS OF THE AGREEMENT; AUTHORIZING THE MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT.

WHEREAS, the City of Marathon (“City”) routinely purchases signage from Municipal Supply & Sign Co; and

WHEREAS, the City is required by FHWA to meet current retroreflectivity criteria mandated since January 22, 2008; and

WHEREAS, there is grant money available for upgrading signage through a 3M® Grant; and

WHEREAS, funding is available in Street Maintenance accounts for this signage.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.

Section 2. The City Council hereby approves entering into an agreement with Municipal Supply & Sign Co. for new signage meeting FHWA criteria in an amount not to exceed \$35,000 using 3M® grant funding.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.


