**CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA
RESOLUTION 2009-166**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
MARATHON, FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING THE NUMBER OF
WASTEWATER EQUIVALENT DWELLIN UNITS AVAILABLE FOR
LEASE BY THE CITY PURSUANT TO CITY OF MARATHON
ORDINANCE 2009-25; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

WHEREAS, the City of Marathon (the “City”) has adopted Ordinance 2009-25 (the “Ordinance”), which authorizes the establishment of a wastewater equivalent dwelling unit (the “Wastewater EDU”) leasing program to be administered by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the Ordinance provides for the establishment of a cap on the number of Wastewater EDUs available for lease by Wastewater Service Area, said cap to be established by resolution upon the recommendation of the City Manager.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, THAT:


Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.

Section 2. Based upon the recommendation of the Acting City Manager, who has considered such things as availability of EDUs, capacity of each Wastewater Service Area, cost, etc., the City Council hereby establishes the initial cap on the number of Wastewater EDUs available for lease pursuant to the Ordinance to be one hundred (100).

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.


