OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, that:**


Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.



1. Transfer of a building permit upon change of ownership. \$350.00
2. Renew expired permit (120) days) per MCC Section 6-40(e) (2) (within 60 days after expiration) \$150.00
3. Special Events:
No charge for non-profit organizations
4. Anything not specifically identified within this fee schedule, will be \$25.00 per \$1,000.00 of value.
5. Administrative Permit to clear previously expired permit that did not have a final inspection. \$ 30.00
