CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA RESOLUTION 2009-78

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA REVISING THE ATTACHMENT (TABLE 6.1) TO ORDINANCE 2008-031; WHICH AMENDS TABLE 6-1 OF THE CITY'S COMPREHENSIVE PLAN; PROVIDING FOR TRANSMITTAL OF THE REVISED TABLE IN ORDINANCE 2008-31 TO THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AFFAIRS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE UPON THE APPROVAL OF THIS RESOLUTION

WHERAS, the City of Marathon (the "City") adopted Ordinance 2008-31 amending its annual Capital Improvements Element (CIE) in the City's Comprehensive Plan (aka Five Year Capital Improvements Program, Fiscal Year 2009-1013); and

WHEREAS, the Ordinance 2008-31 was transmitted to the State Department of Community Affairs and other required agencies for review; and

WHEREAS, the State Department of Community Affairs (State) requested that a line item in the CIE be removed concerning Boot Key Bridge repairs in which said item indicated "tbd" as the cost; and

WHEREAS, the City has agreed with the State to revise the CIE;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA THAT:

- **Section 1.** Table 6-1 as attached to Ordinance 2008-31 which amends the Comprehensive Plan of the City of Marathon, Florida is hereby revised to read as attached (Attachment A).
- **Section 2.** The provisions of Ordinance 2008-31 are otherwise declared to be severable and if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of the Ordinance shall for any reason be declared to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, sentences, clauses, and phrases of Ordinance 2008-31 but they shall remain in effect, it being the legislative intent that this Ordinance shall stand notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.
- **Section 3.** The provisions of Ordinance 2008-31 constitute a "Land Development Regulation" as defined by State law. Accordingly, the City Clerk is authorized to forward a copy of this Resolution to the DCA for approval as a revision to Ordinance 2008-31 pursuant to Sections 380.05(6) and (11), Florida Statutes.

Section 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
