CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA RESOLUTION 2010-17

A RESOLUTION OF CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA ELECTING TO USE THE UNIFORM METHOD OF COLLECTING NON-AD VALOREM SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS LEVIED WITHIN THE INCORPORATED AREA OF THE CITY; STATING A NEED FOR SUCH LEVY; PROVIDING FOR THE MAILING OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Marathon, Florida (the "City") is contemplating the imposition of special assessments for the provision of wastewater utility services and infrastructure within the City; and

WHEREAS, the City intends to use the uniform method for collecting non-ad valorem special assessments for the cost of providing wastewater utility services and infrastructure to property within the incorporated area of the City as authorized by Section 197.3632, *Florida Statutes*, as amended, because this method will allow such special assessments to be collected annually commencing in November 2010, in the same manner as provided for ad valorem taxes; and

WHEREAS, the City held a duly advertised public hearing prior to the adoption of this Resolution, proof of publication of such hearing being attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA THAT:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. Commencing with the Fiscal Year beginning on October 1, 2010, and with the tax statement mailed for such Fiscal Year and continuing thereafter until discontinued by the City, the City intends to use the uniform method of collecting non-ad valorem assessments authorized in section 197.3632, *Florida Statutes*, as amended, for collecting non-ad valorem assessments for the cost of providing wastewater utility services and infrastructure. Such non-ad valorem assessments shall be levied within the incorporated area of the City. A legal description of such area subject to the assessment is attached hereto as Exhibit "B" and incorporated herein by reference.

<u>Section 3.</u> The City hereby determines that the levy of the assessments is needed to fund the cost of wastewater utility services and infrastructure within the incorporated area of the City.

<u>Section 4.</u> Upon adoption, the City Clerk is hereby directed to send a copy of this Resolution by United States mail to the Florida Department of Revenue, the Monroe County Tax Collector, and the Monroe County Property Appraiser by March 1, 2010.

<u>Section 5</u>. This Resolution shall be effective upon adoption.

EXHIBIT B LEGAL DESCRIPTION CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED AS

Land description.—The corporate boundaries of the city shall be as follows: from the East end of the Seven Mile Bridge (approximately Mile Marker 47) to the West end of the Tom's Harbor Bridge (approximately Mile Marker 60), including, but not limited to, the entire islands of Knight Key; Hog Key; Vaca Key; Stirrup Key; Boot Key; Crawl Key; East Sister's Island; West Sister's Island; Fat Deer Key; Long Point Key; Deer Key; Little Deer Key; Little Crawl Key; Grassy Key; the unincorporated areas of Monroe County commonly known as Marathon and Coco Plum; all land filled in between the islands, including all islands connected by U.S. 1, Overseas Highway and roadways connecting thereto; and all adjacent islands not connected by roadways within the boundaries of Monroe County between Mile Marker 47 and Mile marker 60, specifically excluding all areas within the boundaries of the City of Key Colony Beach, all of the above being within the boundaries of Monroe County, Florida.
