CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA RESOLUTION 2010-96

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, ADOPTING THE FINAL MILLAGE RATE AND LEVY OF AD VALOREM TAXES FOR THE CITY OF MARATHON OF MONROE COUNTY, FLORIDA FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2010-2011; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 200.065, *Florida Statutes* the City of Marathon, Florida (the "City") has established a proposed millage rate; and

WHEREAS, the gross taxable value for operating purposes not exempt from taxation within Monroe County has been certified by the County Property Appraiser to the City as \$2,005,323,389; and

WHEREAS, on September 9, 2010, the City Council held a public hearing to consider any adjustment of its proposed millage rate, to adopt a tentative millage rate, and to adopt a tentative operating budget for Fiscal Year 2010-2011 (the "FY 2010-2011"), in accordance with Section 200.065(2)(c), *Florida Statutes* and

WHEREAS, on September 14, 2010, the City Council held a public hearing to consider any adjustment of its tentative millage rate, to adopt a final millage rate and to adopt a final operating budget for FY 2010-2011, in accordance with Section 200.065(2)(d), *Florida Statutes*.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The FY 2010-2011 final operating millage rate for the City is 1.8458 mills, which is less than the rolled-back rate of 1.8931 mills by 2.50%.

Section 2. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon its adoption.
