**CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA
RESOLUTION 2011-41**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH SIEMENS WATER TECHNOLOGIES CORP. FOR THE RE-PRIMING OF THE TREATMENT PLANT TANK UTILIZED IN SERVICE AREA #7 WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$30,000; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY AND EXPEND BUDGETED FUNDS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Marathon (the "City") had contracted with Siemens Water Technologies Corp. ("Siemens") for the fabrication of the SBR treatment tank and other plant equipment for the Service Area #7 Wastewater Treatment Plant; and

WHEREAS, due to time delays to secure a replacement contractor to complete the treatment plant, the tank must now be re-primed.

WHEREAS, Siemens has submitted a proposal to the City to re-prime the tank for a cost not to exceed \$30,000; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to move forward with this work on a timely basis;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, THAT:


Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.

Section 2. The City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into an Agreement with Siemens Water Technologies Corp. to re-prime the tank of the SA7 Treatment Plant. The City Manager is authorized to execute the Agreement and expend up to \$30,000 of budgeted funds on behalf of the City.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
