

**RESOLUTION 2011-76**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA,  
ADOPTING THE TENTATIVE LEVY OF AD VALOREM TAXES FOR  
THE CITY OF MARATHON OF MONROE COUNTY, FLORIDA FOR  
THE FISCAL YEAR 2011-2012; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE  
DATE**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 200.065, *Florida Statutes* the City of Marathon, Florida (the "City") has established a proposed millage rate; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 200.065(2)(c), *Florida Statutes*, within eighty (80) days of certification of taxable value to re-compute the proposed millage rate and adopt a tentative millage rate; and

**WHEREAS**, on September 8, 2011, the City Council held a public hearing to consider any adjustment of its proposed millage rate, to consider its tentative operating budget for Fiscal Year 2011-2012 (the "FY 2011-2012"), and adopt a tentative millage rate in accordance with Section 200.065, *Florida Statutes*.


**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** The FY 2011-2012 tentative operating millage rate for the City is 1.9999 mills, which is less than the rolled-back rate of 2.0188 mills by .94%.

**Section 2.** This resolution shall be effective immediately upon its adoption.
