RESOLUTION 2012-102**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA,
ADOPTING THE FINAL MILLAGE RATE AND LEVY OF AD
VALOREM TAXES FOR THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA FOR
FISCAL YEAR 2012-2013; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE
DATE**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 200.065, *Florida Statutes* the City of Marathon, Florida (the "City") has established a proposed millage rate; and

WHEREAS, the gross taxable value for operating purposes not exempt from taxation within Monroe County has been certified by the County Property Appraiser to the City as \$1,773,259,439; and

WHEREAS, on September 11, 2012, the City Council held a public hearing to consider any adjustment of its proposed millage rate, to adopt a tentative millage rate, and to adopt a tentative operating budget for Fiscal Year 2012-2013 (the "FY 2012-2013"), in accordance with Section 200.065(2)(c), *Florida Statutes* and

WHEREAS, on September 25, 2012, the City Council held a public hearing to consider any adjustment of its tentative millage rate, to adopt a final millage rate and to adopt a final operating budget for FY 2012-2013, in accordance with Section 200.065(2)(d), *Florida Statutes*.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA THAT:**

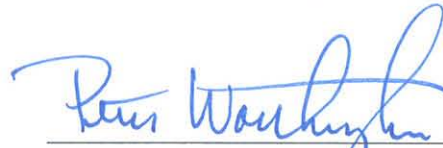
Section 1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. The FY 2012-2013 final operating millage rate for the City of Marathon is 2.1989 mills, which is more than the rolled-back rate of 2.0512 mills by 7.20%.

Section 3. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon its adoption.

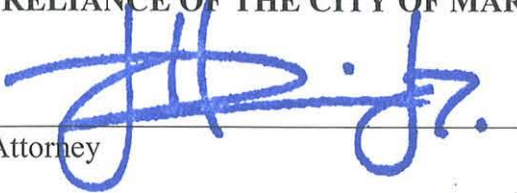
