CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA RESOLUTION 2012-28

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA APPROVING THE RANKINGS AND ALLOCATIONS OF THE COMMERCIAL BUILDING PERMIT APPLICATION SYSTEM (CBPAS); CONDITIONALLY AWARDING 4,260 SQUARE FEET OF CBPAS TO J & L ACQUISITIONS; FOR PERIOD 2, YEAR 7; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, on March 13, 2012, the City Council (the "Council") of the City of Marathon (the "City") conducted a properly advertised public hearing (the "Public Hearing") regarding the commercial floor area ranking and allocation applications for Period 2, Year 7; pursuant to Chapter 107 Article 1 of the Marathon Code (the "Code"); and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.

Section 2. Based upon the information and documented evidence presented by City Staff and members of the public, the City Council hereby makes the following Findings of Fact:

Commercial Building Permit Allocation (CBPAS)

- (1) The Public Hearing was properly advertised and held, as required by law, and the Applicant(s) and all interested parties concerned in the matter were given an opportunity to be heard; and
- (2) City staff recommended the City Council award 10,483 square feet of Commercial Floor Area to the applicants as set forth in Attachment "A" attached hereto.
- (3) The City Council conditionally approves the allocation of 4,260 square feet of CBPAS to J & L Acquisitions.

Section 3. Based upon the above Findings of Fact, the City Council does hereby make the following Conclusions of Law:

- (1) The CBPAS applications for Period 2, Year 7 of CBPAS have been processed in accordance with Chapter 107 Article 1 of the Code.
- (2) In rendering its decision, as reflected in this Resolution, the City Council has:

- (a) Accorded procedural due process;
- (b) Observed the essential requirements of the law; and
- (c) Supported its decision by substantial competent evidence of record.
- The CBPAS allocations as set forth in Attachment "A" attached hereto are awarded, (3) subject to the following condition:
 - (a) The CBPAS allocation for J&L Acquisitions approved herein is subject to final approval by the City Council and Florida Department of Economic Opportunity of a pending Conditional Use Application and Request for Variance to setbacks.

Section 4. This Resolution shall not take effect until after thirty (30) days following the date it is filed with the City Clerk, during which time the approvals herein shall be subject to appeal as provided in the Code.
