RESOLUTION 2018-29**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, ACCEPTING THE RANKING AND RECOMMENDATION OF THE CITY'S EVALUATION TEAM OF THE EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT CONSULTING SERVICES RFP; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AND CITY ATTORNEY TO NEGOTIATE A CONTRACT WITH THE TOP RANKED FIRM OF EARLY ALERT, INC; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Marathon (the "City") published a Request for Proposals (RFP) from experienced emergency management consulting firms to provide consulting services to the City in the event of a natural or man-made disaster; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager established an "Evaluation Team" consisting of City Staff to review, evaluate and rank qualifications packages in accordance with the RFP criteria; and

WHEREAS, on March 20th, the City received three timely responses to the RFP which were subsequently reviewed and evaluated by the City's Evaluation Team; and

WHEREAS, the City recommends and requests the Council authorize the City Manager to negotiate a contract with the top ranked firm of Early Alert, Inc.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.

Section 2. The City Council accepts the City's Evaluation Team ranking and authorizes the City Manager and City Attorney to negotiate a contracts with Early Alert, Inc.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
