

**CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA
RESOLUTION 2018-41**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, ACCEPTING THE RANKING AND RECOMMENDATION OF THE CITY'S EVALUATION TEAM OF THE CODE ENFORCEMENT SPECIAL MAGISTRATE RFQ; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AND CITY ATTORNEY TO NEGOTIATE A CONTRACT WITH THE TOP RESPONDENT, JAMES (JACK) BRIDGES AND A CONTRACT FOR AN ALTERNATE SPECIAL MAGISTRATE WITH THE SECOND RANKED RESPONDENT, ANNA HUBICKI; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Marathon (the "City") published a Request for Quotations (RFQ) for a Code Enforcement Special Magistrate; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager established an "Evaluation Team" consisting of City Staff to review, evaluate and rank qualifications packages in accordance with the RFQ criteria; and

WHEREAS, on March 28th, the City received four (4) timely responses to the RFQ which were subsequently reviewed and evaluated by the City's Evaluation Team; and

WHEREAS, the City recommends and requests the Council authorize the City Manager and City Attorney to negotiate a contract with the top ranked submittal from James (Jack) Bridges and a contract for an alternate special magistrate with the second ranked submittal from Anna Hubicki.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.

Section 2. The City Council accepts the City's Evaluation Team ranking and authorizes the City Manager and City Attorney to negotiate a contract with the top ranked submittal from James (Jack) Bridges and a contract for an alternate special magistrate with the second ranked submittal from Anna Hubicki.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
