RESOLUTION 2018-114**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING A “PIGGY-BACK” PURCHASE PURSUANT TO THE CITY’S PURCHASING POLICIES AND PROCEDURES AND APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF A CHEVY DUMP TRUCK UNDER THE FLORIDA SHERIFF’S BID 2019-120716-NAF FROM ALAN JAY FLEET SALES, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$55,152.00; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENTS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, APPROPRIATING AND EXPENDING BUDGETED FUNDS WHICH WILL BE SUBMITTED FOR REIMBURSEMENT FROM THE FDEP GRANT; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance 2015-04, the City adopted purchasing policies and procedures (the “Purchasing Policies and Procedures”) after determining that it was fiscally prudent and in the City’s best interest to adopt policies and procedures for City employees and officials regarding the acquisition and purchase of contractual services, equipment, goods, and other similar types of services; and

WHEREAS, the Purchasing Policies and Procedures allow the City Council to enter into contracts for materials, supplies, equipment, public improvements or services without competitive bidding by utilizing existing contract terms and prices entered into by other local, state or federal governmental authorities that followed a competitive bidding procedure leading to the award of the contract in question; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to take advantage of the Florida Sheriffs’ Association Contract No. 2019-120716-NAF from Alan Jay Fleet Sales, to purchase a Chevy Dump Truck in an amount not to exceed \$51,152.00, which will be submitted for reimbursement from the FDEP Grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.

Section 2. The City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into an agreement and expend budgeted funds on behalf of the City for the purchase of a Chevy Dump Truck in an amount not to exceed \$55,152.00.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
