RESOLUTION 2014-115**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA,
ADOPTING THE FINAL MILLAGE RATE AND LEVY OF AD
VALOREM TAXES FOR THE CITY OF MARATHON OF MONROE
COUNTY, FLORIDA FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2014-2015; AND
PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 200.065, *Florida Statutes* the City of Marathon, Florida (the "City") has established a proposed millage rate; and

WHEREAS, on September 16, 2014, the City Council held a public hearing to consider any adjustment of its proposed millage rate, to adopt a tentative millage rate, and to adopt a tentative operating budget for Fiscal Year 2014-2015 (the "FY 2014-2015"), in accordance with Section 200.065(2)(c), *Florida Statutes* and

WHEREAS, on September 23, 2014, the City Council held a public hearing to consider any adjustment of its tentative millage rate, to adopt a final millage rate and to adopt a final operating budget for FY 2014-2015, in accordance with Section 200.065(2)(d), *Florida Statutes*.


**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The FY 2014-2015 final operating millage rate for the City is 2.3297 mills, which is more than/less than the rolled-back rate of 2.2097 mills by 5.43%.

Section 2. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon its adoption.


