Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.

Section 2. In order to establish minimum qualifications and rules of conduct for the appointed members of all City boards, committees, and commissions the City Boards, Committees and Commissions Policy and Procedure attached hereto as Exhibit "A" is hereby approved.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon it adoption.

EXHIBIT "A"

CITY BOARDS, COMMITTEES AND COMMISSIONS POLICY AND PROCEDURE

- 1. The following policies and procedures relating to the appointment of boards, committees, and commissions' members shall apply to all individuals seeking appointment thereto:
 - a. Appointment to a City board, committee or commission is a privilege, not a right.
 - b. Individuals desiring to serve on a City board, committee, or commission must complete the attached application prior to the appointment being considered by the City Council or Councilmember. Prior to the expiration date of an appointee's term, an appointee seeking reappointment must file with the City Council or Councilmember (copy to City Clerk) that appointed them a statement of intent to seek reappointment in lieu of a full application. The statement shall indicate whether or not any of the information on the initial application has changed; and if so, state with specificity what information changed.
 - c. Board, committee, and commission members must provide proof that they are registered to vote in the City of Marathon.
- 2. If a board, committee or commission member is arrested for any crime which is punishable as a felony or with any crime arising out of his or her official duties, the member must notify the City Clerk as soon as possible. The member shall be automatically suspended from office if the arrest is related to the member's official duties. Upon notification the City Clerk will place on the agenda of the next regularly scheduled Council meeting as a discussion item the potential suspension of the board, committee or commission member pending a final disposition of the member's arrest.
