**WHEREAS**, the City Council believes it is in the City's best interest to modify the City Hall design through work authorization Option No. 1 to the professional services agreement with William P. Horn, Architect, P.A. for the Project.

# NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, THAT:

- **Section 1**. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.
- **Section 2.** Optional Work Authorization No.1 To The Professional Services Agreement between the City and William P. Horn, Architect, P.A. for the Project, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "A;" together with such non-material changes as may be acceptable to the Acting City Manager and approved as to form and legality by the City Attorney is hereby approved. The Acting City Manager is authorized to execute the Optional Work Authorization No.1 to the Professional Services Agreement and expend appropriated funds on behalf of the City.
  - **Section 3.** This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
