RESOLUTION 2015-08**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING A “PIGGY BACK PURCHASE” PURSUANT TO THE CITY’S PROCUREMENT POLICIES AND PROCEDURES AND AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF AN AMBULANCE FROM THE FLORIDA SHERIFF’S CONTRACT BID #11-10-1202 SPECIFICATION #03 TYPE II AMBULANCE, VAN (4X2) IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$109,998.00; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXPEND BUDGETED FUNDS ON BEHALF OF THE CITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance 2014-15, the City adopted purchasing policies and procedures (the “Purchasing Policies and Procedures”) after determining that it was fiscally prudent and in the City’s best interest to adopt policies and procedures for City employees and officials regarding the acquisition and purchase of contractual services, equipment, goods, and other similar types of services; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-184(C) of the City’s Purchasing Policies and Procedures allow the City Council to enter into contracts for materials, supplies, equipment, public improvements or services without competitive bidding by utilizing existing contract terms and prices entered into by other local, state or federal governmental authorities that followed a competitive bidding procedure leading to the award of the contract in question; and

WHEREAS, the existing transfer unit, a 2012 Sprinter, has in excess of 150,000 miles since December 2012. The purchase of the new ambulance transfer unit will limit out of service times for interfacility transfers and afford an additional unit should one be required in an emergency, additional transfers and for disaster readiness. The City desires to acquire a second type II ambulance van to meet the demands and continue the high level of service and safety to the City and its residents; and

WHEREAS, the \$109,998.00 cost of the Type II ambulance is based on the competitively bid Florida Sheriff’s Association Bid #11-10-1202, as required by the Purchasing Policies and Procedures.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, that:


Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.

Section 2. The City Council authorizes the City Manager to expend budgeted funds with Emergency Tactical Rescue Vehicles for the purchase of a Type II ambulance van in an amount not to exceed \$109,998.00 based on the competitively bid Florida Sheriff’s Association Bid #11-10-1202

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.


