#### CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA RESOLUTION 2015-104

A RESOLUTION OF CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, ADOPTING THE FINAL BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2015-2016; AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS ESTABLISHED BY THE BUDGET; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the gross taxable value for operating purposes not exempt from taxation within Monroe County has been certified by the County Property Appraiser to the City as \$2,015,957,821; and

**WHEREAS,** on <u>September 8, 2015</u>, the City Council held a public hearing to consider any adjustment of its proposed millage rate, to adopt a tentative millage, and to adopt a tentative operating budget for Fiscal Year 2015-2016 (the "FY 2015-2016"), in accordance with Section 200.065(2)(c), *Florida Statutes*; and

WHEREAS, on <u>September 22, 2015</u>, the City Council held a public hearing to consider any adjustment of its tentative millage rate, to adopt a final millage rate, and to adopt a final operating budget for FY 2015-2016, in accordance with Section 200.065(2)(d), *Florida Statutes*; and

**WHEREAS,** the City has set forth the appropriations and revenue estimate for the final operating budget for FY 2015-2016 in the amount of \$68,303,560. A copy of the City's final budget is attached as Exhibit "A."

## NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1.** The FY 2015-2016 final operating budget is adopted.
- **Section 2.** Funds appropriated in the FY 2015-2016 budget may be expended by and with the approval of the City Manager in accordance with the City Charter, State law, and the ordinances, resolutions and policies and procedures of the City. Supplemental appropriations or the reduction of appropriations, if any, shall be made in accordance with the City Charter.
  - **Section 3.** This resolution shall be effective immediately upon its adoption.
