RESOLUTION 2016-16**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING A “PIGGY BACK PURCHASE” PURSUANT TO THE CITY’S PROCUREMENT POLICIES AND PROCEDURES AND AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF OFFICE FURNITURE AND EQUIPMENT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$250,000.00 FROM KI; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXPEND BUDGETED FUNDS ON BEHALF OF THE CITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance 2014-15, the City adopted purchasing policies and procedures (the “Purchasing Policies and Procedures”) after determining that it was fiscally prudent and in the City’s best interest to adopt policies and procedures for City employees and officials regarding the acquisition and purchase of contractual services, equipment, goods, and other similar types of services; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-184(C) of the City’s Purchasing Policies and Procedures allow the City Council to enter into contracts for materials, supplies, equipment, public improvements or services without competitive bidding by utilizing existing contract terms and prices entered into by other local, state or federal governmental authorities that followed a competitive bidding procedure leading to the award of the contract in question; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to acquire office furniture to meet the needs of staff and residences in furnishing the new city hall; and

WHEREAS, the cost of the furniture in an amount not to exceed \$250,000 is based on the competitively bid Florida State Contract Bid #425-001-12-1 and 420-420-10-1, as required by the Purchasing Policies and Procedures; and

WHEREAS, in order to offset the costs of acquiring this furniture, staff requests the Council to surplus the furnishings that will not be used in the new city hall.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARATHON, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.

Section 2. The City Council authorizes the City Manager to expend budgeted funds with KI for the purchase of furnishings to furnish the new city hall in an amount not to exceed \$250,000.00 based on the competitively bid Florida State Contract Bid # 425-001-12-1 and 420-420-10-1 and approves the surplus of the current furnishings.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
